



Alabama Gun Collectors Association Scholarship

The Alabama Gun Collectors Association scholarship is awarded to high school seniors or post-secondary undergraduate candidates who have demonstrated leadership in supporting the purposes of the AGCA.

Eligibility requirements:

- Recipient must be knowledgeable regarding Second Amendment rights
- Recipient must have a 3.0 minimum grade point average

Award type:

- An outright grant by the AGCA Scholarship committee
- Amount to be determined yearly by the AGCA Board of Directors


Application procedure:

- Applications must be received by the AGCA Secretary/Treasurer, in person or by mail at P.O. Box #242277, Montgomery, AL 36124-2277 by January 15.
- Application form must contain signatures of recommendation by two persons over the age of 18 not related to the applicant, and all questions on the application form must be completed accurately and truthfully
- Application form must be accompanied by a certified school transcript from the current academic year, clearly showing the student's grade point average, and an original essay written by the applicant in compliance with the directions on the application form

Selection process:

- Student's application package will be forwarded to the chairperson of the AGCA Scholarship Award Committee, members of which are appointed by the President of the AGCA
- AGCA Scholarship Award Committee will review and select the winning applicant based on the guidelines established for the AGCA scholarship, and the committee's decision shall be final and absolute
- The winner will be notified by the President of AGCA

Support your position with reasoning and examples taken from your reading, studies, experiences or observations.
